The Problem: Overburdened Systems



will find themselves in foster care this year.



On average, a child will spend **nearly** a year in foster care.



Each child will change homes an average of five times.

The Solution: Citizen Volunteers

Trained CASA volunteers help abused and neglected children find safe, permanent homes.




CASA Programs Change Lives
